The Radcliff Club hosted the 2nd Qtr KY/WV District meeting at the Gold Vault Inn in Radcliff, KY, February 8-10, 2019. Some 40 Optimists from the district attended this Friday through Sunday event where plans for upcoming events such as the Essay Contest and Oratorical Contest were discussed. This year's planning for the 100th Optimist International Annual Convention took center stage as the District will be the host organization. The first OI Convention was also held in Louisville, so the challenge of

preparing for this year's convention is much greater than usual.

KY/WV District Gov. Jean Smith presided over the meeting. A highlight of quarterly meetings is the selection of a charity for special support. This quarter, Helping Hands of Hope's Program "Beds for Kids" was nominated and selected. Helping Hands of Hope's Director Gary Bohannon addressed the group and shared that many kids in Hardin County do not have a bed in which to sleep every night. The Beds for Kids program provides brand new

beds for a nominal fee to families in need. Bohannon told the Radcliff Optimist Club about the program earlier in the year and explained that there is a real need for new pillows and blankets to be given with beds. The District delivered with a sizeable donation of bedding that required two hotel dollies to get it all into Bohannon's car.

The meeting was not all serious business, however. A closing moviethemed costume dinner with games was held at the Northside Hall in Radcliff on Saturday evening.

Change coming for Kentucky drivers license

Kentucky is making signifiimprovecant ments to increase the security of the identity credential you rely on most through Confident Kentucky initiative. Following a statewide rollout starting in March 2019 and ending in May, all driver's licenses, permits and personal IDs will have new security features. They

will arrive in the mail 5-10 business days after residents apply at their local Circuit Court Clerk's office, and will be moving to an eight-year lifespan and have new pricing.

The next time you renew your current credential or if you are a first-time cardholder, you'll choose a credential in one of two new versions: standard or Voluntary Travel ID credential.

Voluntary Travel ID versions have all the benefits of a standard credential plus they are federally accepted to board U.S. domestic flights and access restricted federal facilities once REAL ID enforcement begins nationwide on October 1, 2020.

Documentation is required when



for a applying Voluntary Travel ID, if you are a first-time cardholder or if you want a standard credential and your personal information has changed. Be confident you'll arrive prepared when applying for a new credential by following the steps below or choosing from the menu of resources:
